How I take note of a run.
It is fairly intuitive.
I note with a capital T where I arrive with the first roll (Tree roll).
With an L the Launch roll, the "Tr" the track roll, and (you guessed it?) with an F the Finish roll.

The small bold number to the left of the racing track are simply a reminder of the bracket pairing, not the assigned lane.
The small number above the racing track, is the turn assigned for that pair to take their elimination run.

As you can see there is also space for some quick notation on single dice roll.
Or even draw the cloud of smoke when you blow up the engine in the middle of the run...
