*Injuries to FIVE prime players significantly altered a Giants' season which began with hopes of being a strong contender: "Buster" Posey (hip surgery) was lost for the year August 25<sup>th</sup>. Johnny Cueto--with a 0.35 ERA after four starts--went on the disabled list August 1<sup>st</sup> for "Tommy John" elbow surgery. Jeff Samardzija was on the DL THREE times before being lost to the team for the year, July 15<sup>th</sup>. Joe Panik spent time on the DL from 7-30 July and Madison Bumgarner did not return from a broken pinky finger until June 5<sup>th</sup>. He picked up career strikeout 1,500 June 27<sup>th</sup> at Colorado...Newcomer Evan Longoria led the Giants with 16 home runs. Andrew McCutchen, before a trade to the Yankees, wound up topping the ball club with 55 RBI and 65 runs scored. The leader in hits (135) was Brandon Crawford. The Giants hit for a .239 average and 133 home runs...The pitching staff ended the year with a respectable 3.95 ERA, seventh in the N. L. Chris Stratton posted the most wins (10) and Derek Holland the most strikeouts (169)...After the season's mid-point, the team came no closer than 2 ½ games of first on July 1<sup>st</sup>... "Mac" Williamson's birth name is Johnathan Mackensey.*
