The National League champion Redbirds lost the World Series, four games to two, to the Red Sox in skipper Mike Matheny's second season as manager. The Cards beat the Pirates in the NLDS, 3-2, and knocked off the Dodgers in the NLCS, 4-2...Even before the season began, the Cardinals had to promote minor leaguers to replace three important regular players lost for the entire year: Pitchers Chris Carpenter and Jason Motte as well as infielder Rafael Furcal. Lefthanded pitcher Jaime Garcia would be lost for the remainder of the season, May 18<sup>th</sup>, with a left shoulder strain...Team leaders: Carlos Beltran (24 homers, 84 RBI) and Allen Craig (13 dingers, 97 RBI). Matt Holliday blasted 22 home runs, drove in ninety-four, and crossed home plate 103 times. Matt Carpenter, who added eleven homers, led the ball club in hits (199) and runs scored (126). The Cards led the N.L. in runs scored (783) and were second in batting average (.269). They hit 125 home runs and led the league in doubles (322)...Adam Wainwright led the pitching staff with 19 wins and 219 strikeouts. He pitched five complete games including two shutouts. Lance Lynn and highly touted youngster Shelby Miller both won fifteen games apiece. The former struck out 198 batters and the latter one hundred sixty-nine. Reliever Trevor Rosenthal whiffed 108 batters. Spot starter Joe Kelly won ten games in fifteen starting assignments. The staff ERA was fifth in the N.L. at 3.42 and in strikeouts (1,254).
