Saddled with plummeting attendance and uninspiring teams playing in an ice-box of a ball park, the Giants' long-time owner, Horace Stoneham, nearly sold the team in '76 to parties interested in moving the franchise to Toronto. A local group stepped up at the last moment and bought the Giants to keep the team in the Bay Area. (There had also been preliminary talks of moving the team BACK to the NYC metropolitan area to play at a site in the New Jersey Meadowlands.)...The Giants completed their 19th season on the West Coast after moving from New York prior to the 1958 campaign...Bobby Murcer led the ball club with 23 homers and 90 RBI. Gary Matthews was right behind with 20 home runs and 84 RBI...As a team, the Giants hit .246 with 85 homers...John Montefusco led the pitching staff with 16 wins, 172 strikeouts, eleven complete games and six shutouts. Starter Jim Barr won fifteen contests. Ed Halicki was 12-14 with 130 K's. The staff's ERA was 3.53 and led the N.L. with 13 shutouts. They also allowed the majors' fewest home runs (68)...The Giants split their season series with the N.L. Champion, Reds, 9-9. They DID win two series, both 10-8, over the Dodgers and Padres. Attendance was last in the N.L.: 626,868.
