A GREAT ball club. (Many baseball "experts" believe THIS Orioles squad is one of the BEST EVER.) Before the 1969 World Series, the New York Mets were given NO CHANCE to beat this team. "The Amazins" pulled the BIG upset in five games...For The Birds, the best was yet to come...Clay Dalrymple was two for two as a pinch-hitter in the Series for Baltimore...

Team leaders: Boog Powell (37 homers, 121 RBI); Frank Robinson (32 homers, 100 RBI, 111 runs scored); Mike Cuellar (23 wins, 182 strikeouts, 18 complete games); Dave McNally (20 wins, 166 strikeouts). Jim Palmer was 16-4 with 123 punch outs, 11 complete games, and six shutouts. Paul Blair added 26 home runs, 76 RBI, and led The Birds with 178 base hits. He also scored 102 runs. Brooks Robinson chipped in with 23 homers and 84 runs batted in. "The Human Vacuum Cleaner" also won his tenth straight Gold Glove Award at third base...The Orioles were second in the American League with a .265 batting average. They were third with 175 home runs and second after scoring 775 times...The staff ERA (2.83) was the best in the A.L. Across the board, the hurlers were first with 19 shutouts; likewise, they yielded the fewest hits, runs, home runs, and bases on balls. They led the American League in fielding and committed the fewest errors...The Orioles' closest pursuer in the AL East, Detroit, was 19 games behind at the end of the season. The O's won the season series, 11-7... "The Earl of Baltimore" led his ball club to a sweep of the Twins in the first ever American League Championship Series to move to the Fall Classic... "Chico" Salmon's birth name is Ruthford.
