"Lefty" Phillips assumed managerial duties, May 27th. He replaced Bill Rigney who had managed the Angels since their inception into the A.L. in 1961. Managers' records: Rigney (11-28) and Phillips (60-63)...Team leaders: Rick Reichardt (13 homers, 68 RBI) and Jim Fregosi (12 home runs, 47 RBI). Fregosi led the ball club in hits (151) and runs scored (78). Jim Spencer and Jay Johnstone both hit ten homers. Johnstone was second with 59 RBI. The Angels were LAST in the A.L. with a .230 batting average and 88 home runs...Andy Messersmith led the pitching staff with 16 wins, 211 strikeouts, and ten complete games. Tom Murphy and lefty Rudy May both won ten contests. May struck out 133 batters. The staff ERA was 3.54, sixth in the league... California finished third, 26 games out of first place in the new AL West Division and 17 games out of second.
