Rico Petrocelli and Carl Yastrzemski each hit 40 homers to lead the ball club. "Yaz" had the most RBI (111) and runs scored (96). Petrocelli drove home 97 runs. Reggie Smith had 25 homers, 93 RBI, and a team leading 168 base hits. Tony Conigliaro came back with a nice year (20 homers, 82 RBI) after his recovery from being struck in the face by a pitched ball at Anaheim during the '67 season. George Scott added 16 dingers while Mike Andrews cracked 15 home runs. For the year, the Bosox hit .251 and led the A.L. with 197 homers. Ray Culp led the pitching staff with a 17-8 record, 172 strikeouts, nine complete games, and two shutouts. "Sonny" Siebert was 14-10 and Mike Nagy 12-2 on the season. Closer "Sparky" Lyle won eight games out of the pen and struck out ninety-three. The staff ended the campaign with a 3.92 ERA. Boston finished 22 games behind the AL East champion Orioles who won the season series, 10-8. The Bostons handled the Yankees, winning eleven games to seven. Skipper Dick Williams was fired September 22nd with nine games to go in the season. He had a record of 82-71. In three years managing the Red Sox, Williams' record was 260-217 with one American League pennant (1967).
