The Royals' second season saw them finish 33 games behind AL West Champion Minnesota...They DID win two season series: 11-7 against the White Sox and 12-6 against Milwaukee who also equaled K. C.'s won/loss record...The Royals were 5-13 versus the Twins while the Orioles won ALL twelve games of the season series against Kansas City...Bob Oliver led the ball club with 27 homers and 99 RBI. Ed Kirkpatrick stroked 18 home runs; Lou Piniella (11 homers) drove home 88 runs. Amos Otis led the team in hits (176) and runs scored (91). He popped eleven home runs...Jim Rooker won 10 games while Bob Johnson whiffed 206 batters to lead the pitching staff...Bob Lemon (46-64) assumed managerial duties, June 9th, an 8-1 win over Washington in Kansas City. Charlie Metro's record was 19-33...For the year, the Royals hit .244 and 97 homers, the latter LAST in the league. The Royals' 41 triples led the American League...The staff ERA was sixth in the A.L. at 3.78.
