The Yankees' 93 wins were the most for the ball club since their last pennant in 1964. New York still finished 15 games behind AL East champion Baltimore who won 108 games...Skipper Ralph Houk was named the Associated Press Manager of the Year...Bobby Murcer led the Yanks with 23 home runs. Roy White followed with 22 dingers and led the ball club with 94 runs batted in, 180 base hits, and 109 runs scored. He also played in all 162 ball games. Murcer was second to White with 78 RBI. Danny Cater, with a meager six homers, had 175 hits for the season and drove in 76 runs. Horace Clarke contributed 172 base knocks. The Yankees were fifth in the A.L with a .251 batting average and eleventh with 111 home runs. "The Bronx Bombers" were first in triples in the American League (41) and second with 105 stolen bases..."Fritz" Peterson posted the most wins on the pitching staff with a 20-11 W/L record and 127 strikeouts. Mel Stottlemyre was 15-13 for the season and led the staff with 14 complete games. Stan Bahnsen was 14-11 and struck out 116 batters. Lindy McDaniel had nine wins out of the bullpen. The Yankee staff was third in the A.L. with a 3.23 ERA...New York was 7-11 in their season series with the Orioles, 8-10 versus Boston.
