The Cubbies didn't finish LAST because the Phillies were WORSE by one game...It wasn't Ernie Banks' fault. All he did was belt 41 homers to lead the major leagues, score ninety-four and drive in one-hundred seventeen to lead the ball club. Banks would finish fourth in N. L. MVP voting and be awarded a Gold Glove at shortstop. Frank Thomas followed with 21 homers and 64 RBI...The pitching leader was Glen Hobbie with a less-than-spectacular 16-20 W/L record and 134 K's. Bob Anderson won nine. The staff ERA was last in the league (4.35)...Cubs batters hit .243 (7th) and 119 home runs (7th)...After their 45th season at Wrigley Field, Chicago finished 35 games in back of the pennant winning Pirates who won the season series, 15-7. The Cubs did not win ONE season series in '60...Managers' records: Grimm (6-11), Boudreau (54-83). Former Indians great and manager Lou Boudreau was named skipper, May 5th.
