Harold Baines led the White Sox--a team on the upswing--with 25 homers and 105 RBI. Baines' cohorts, Greg Luzinski (18 homers, 102 RBI) and Steve Kemp (19 homers, 98 RBI) contributed a lot of offense as well to the 'Sox lineup. Luzinski, the full-time designated hitter, was tops on the Sox with 170 base hits. That total also included a team leading 37 doubles. Kemp, meanwhile, had 166 base knocks and topped the club with 91 runs scored. Catcher Carlton Fisk added 14 dingers and 66 RBI. Chicago was fifth in the A.L. with a .273 batting average and eighth after hitting 136 home runs...On the pitching rubber, Number One starter Dewey LaMarr Hoyt led the staff with 19 wins, 124 strikeouts, and 14 complete games. Lefty Britt Burns followed at 13-5 for the season while Rich Dotson and Dennis Lamp both won eleven contests. Former Met Jerry Koosman started 19 games and won eleven as well with 88 punch outs. The Sox staff ended the year third in the league with a 3.87 ERA...

The Pale Hose finished just six games behind the AL West Division champion Angels who won their season series, 8-5. At the All Star break, the White Sox had achieved a 45-37 record and were only two games out of first place. For the season, they scored 786 runs and allowed 710.
