Nolan Ryan posted a 21-16 W/L record in '73. He struck out 383 batters (a record which stands to this day) for the season. That is 10.574 K's per nine innings. "The Ryan Express" threw two of his seven career no-hitters and struck out at least ten batters in 23 different games. In his second "no-no" of the season, Ryan punched out 17 batters, the most K's for a no-hitter, against the Tigers in Detroit on July 15th. The first one was against the Royals in Kansas City, May 15th. On the flip side, Ryan also walked 162 batters for the year...

Team leaders: DH Frank Robinson (30 home runs, 97 RBI, 85 runs). Now 37-years of age, this was Robinson's last big season as a hitter before moving on to Cleveland and being named the major leagues' first African-American manager. Bob Oliver led the ball club in hits (144) and was second to "Robby" with 18 homers and 89 RBI...Along with Ryan's team leading stats shown above, Bill Singer was a 20-game winner and rang up 241 K's. Lefty Clyde Wright won eleven while Rudy May (seven wins) struck out 134 batters...The Halos finished 15 games behind AL West champion, Oakland, and won six of eighteen games versus the A's...The Angels hit 93 home runs for the season (LAST in the A.L.) and .253 at the plate. The staff ERA was 3.53 with a league leading 1,010 K's and 72 complete games (tops in the majors)--twenty-six of which were thrown by Ryan. He and Rudy May posted four shutouts.
