For the season, the Mets hit .249 and 98 home runs. The pitching staff completed '71 as the premier staff in the National League: the lowest ERA (2.99), the most strikeouts (1,157), and fewest runs allowed (550)...Ed Kranepool, Tommie Agee, and Cleon Jones all hit 14 homers to lead the ball club. Jones was also the leader in RBI (69), base hits (161), and runs scored (63). Kranepool was second with 58 runs batted in and 61 runs. Ken Singleton smacked 13 dingers while Donn Clendenon hit eleven as a platoon player at first base...Tom Seaver anchored the pitching staff with 20 victories, 289 strikeouts, 21 complete games, and four shutouts. He finished second in Cy Young Award voting. Gary Gentry followed with a 12-11 W/L record, 155 K's, and eight complete games. Nolan Ryan ended the year 10-14 and struck out 137 batters while issuing 116 walks. Jerry Koosman had a 6-11 record. Relievers Danny Frisella and "Tug" McGraw had 93 and 109 strikeouts, respectively. The staff was relatively young at an average age just over twenty-six years old...New York ended the year tied with the Cubs 14 games in back of the first place Pirates. They beat the Bucs in their season series, 10-8.
