**First baseman Nate Colbert was the Padres' leader with 27 home runs, 84 RBI, 149 hits, and 81 runs scored. "Cito" Gaston followed with seventeen homers and sixty-one runs batted in. "Downtown" Ollie Brown added nine dingers, 132 hits, and 55 RBI. The ball club was second to last in the N.L. with a .233 batting average, eighth with 96 home runs, and LAST after scoring 486 runs for the year...Clay Kirby led the team with 15 wins; Dave Roberts added 14 victories and led the hurlers in complete games (14). Kirby also led the pitching staff in strikeouts (231). Steve Arlin was 9-19, struck out 156 batters, and was the staff leader with four shutouts. Reliever Bob Miller won seven contests coming out of the 'pen. The pitching staff finished THIRD in the league with a 3.22 ERA, second with 923 strikeouts, and gave up the second fewest home runs (93). Padres pitchers allowed 610 runs to score...Attendance for the year at San Diego Stadium was 557,513...The Padres would finish 28 ½ games behind NL West champion San Francisco and 17 ½ in back of both Cincinnati and Houston...They WON one season series, 8-4, over the Phillies.**
