With the best record in the National League, the D-Backs won the NL West for the first time since 2002 by just one-half game over Colorado. The Rockies would get their revenge in the post-season after sweeping Arizona in the NLCS, four games to none...Centerfielder Chris Young became the first major league rookie to hit at least 30 home runs and steal 25 bases in a season. The prodigal D-Back led the ball club with 32 homers. He knocked in sixty-eight. The main RBI-man was Eric Byrnes who drove home eighty-three and hit 21 dingers. He had team highs in base hits (179) and runs scored (103) as well. Mark Reynolds and utilityman Tony Clark both clubbed seventeen homers...Number One starter Brandon Webb earned that title with 18 wins and 194 K's to lead the pitching staff. Doug Davis won thirteen with 144 strikeouts while Livan Hernandez was an eleven-game winner. Future Hall of Famer Randy Johnson was 4-3 for the year with 72 punch outs...D-Backs' hitters posted a .250 average at the plate and hit 171 homers...The staff ended '07 with a 4.13 ERA and the most saves in the N.L. (51).
