The Rangers finished last, 14 1/2 games behind division champion Kansas City in the American League West...Former Montreal Expo Larry Parrish led the ball club with 22 homers, 101 RBI, and 175 base hits. Gary Ward was next with 21 homers, 79 RBI, and a team high 97 runs scored. Pete O'Brien (18 home runs, 80 RBI) was a consistent offensive contributor and very solid defensively at first base. Third baseman "Buddy" Bell drove home 83 runs, scored eighty-eight, had 174 base knocks, and hit 11 dingers. He also won his sixth consecutive Gold Glove. The Rangers finished the year ninth in the A.L. with a .261 batting average and eleventh with 120 home runs...The pitching staff was led by knuckleballer Charlie Hough who was 16-14, topped the staff with 164 strikeouts, and completed seventeen games. Lefty Frank Tanana was the only other double-digit winner with a 15-15 record, 141 strikeouts, and nine complete games. The one-time fireballing Tanana had transformed himself into a very successful finesse pitcher over the years. Mike Mason was a nine-game winner while Danny Darwin ended the season with an 8-10 record. Dave Stewart won seven ball games. The staff ERA was sixth in the league at 3.91...The Rangers drew just over 1.1 million to Arlington Stadium, placing their attendance twelfth out of fourteen teams... Texas won seven of thirteen games played against Kansas City...The ball club scored 656 runs and allowed 714 for the year.
