Terry Mulholland pitched the first nine-inning no-hitter at Veterans Stadium, August 15th, a 6-0 whitewash of the Giants in front of just over 32,000 fans. It was also the first "no-no" by a Phillies' hurler at home in the 20th century and the eighth no-hitter in the National League in 1990. Mulholland struck out eight and didn't walk a batter. An error prevented a perfect game...This woeful ball club finished eight games ahead of the last place Cardinals. As a team, the Phils hit .255 for the year and 103 home runs. Rightfielder Von Hayes was the leader with 17 homers and 73 RBI. Catcher Darren Daulton was good for 12 dingers and 57 runs batted in. Lenny Dykstra added nine home runs and led the Phillies with 192 base hits and 106 runs scored. Charlie Hayes popped ten homers...Starter Pat Combs led the pitching staff with ten victories and 108 strikeouts. Mulholland was a nine-game winner and the staff leader in complete games (six). Ken Howell and spot-starter Dennis Cook both won eight. The staff finished the year ninth in the N.L. in ERA (4.09)...The Phils were in first place for ONE day by a half-game, May 25th, with a record of 24-16.
