Mike Matheny replaced the retired Tony LaRussa as MGR of the Cards, November 14, 2011. The Cardinals beat the Braves in the N.L. Wild Card Game, then knocked off Washington in the NLDS, three games to two. After the Redbirds led the NLCS, 3-1, the Giants won the last three games to advance to the World Series...Carlos Beltran led the Cards with 32 home runs. He became the first switch-hitter in major league history to hit both 300 homers and steal at least 300 bases in a career. Matt Holliday drove home 102 runs (the most on the team) to go with his 27 homers. He also led the ball club with 177 hits and 97 runs scored. Beltran posted 97 RBI. Yadier Molina and Allen Craig each hit 22 homers. Molina, not the fleetest-of-foot, acquired his 1,000<sup>th</sup> career base hit with an infield single. The Cards hit .271 and 159 homers for the year...Lance Lynn (180 K's) led the pitching staff with an 18-7 record. The strikeout leader was Adam Wainwright (14-13) with 184 punch outs. Kyle Lohse was 16-3 for the year and struck out 143 batters. Jake Westbrook had a 13-win season while closer Jason Motte whiffed 86 opponents.
