Johan Santana no-hit the Cardinals at Citi Field on June 1<sup>st</sup>. It was the first "no-no" in Mets history. Santana needed 134 pitches to strikeout eight and walk five batters. The final score was 8-0. After his no-hitter, Santana was not nearly as brilliant for the rest of his career. The pitching staff's ERA was 4.09 and was led by knuckleballer R. A. Dickey (20 wins, 230 K's). Santana was 6-9 with 111 K's. Lefty Jon Niese ended the year 13-9 in wins/losses... Ike Davis led the ball club with 32 home runs. He drove in ninety. David Wright topped the Mets in RBI (93), base hits (178), runs scored (91), and doubles (41). New York hit .249 and 139 homers... Citi Field's original dimensions were shortened with a sponsor's "party deck" erected in front of the "Great Wall of Flushing" to allow for more home runs in the "pitcher-friendly" park.
