Matt Kemp was the Dodgers' leader with 23 home runs. He was second on the team in RBI (69). Andre Ethier (20 homers) topped the ball club with 89 RBI, 158 base hits, 79 runs scored, and 36 doubles. Back-stop A. J. Ellis socked 13 dingers and drove in fifty-two. L. A. hit .252 for the year and finished fifteenth in the N.L. with 116 homers... Clayton Kershaw (14-9, 229 strikeouts) is the ace of the pitching staff. He struck out 12 Seattle batters in just seven innings, June 9th, at Dodger Stadium. Chris Capuano won 12 games while fellow starters Aaron Harang and Chad Billingsley each put up 10 victories. Closer Kenley Jansen whiffed 99 opponents. The staff ended the year second in the league in ERA (3.34)... L. A. had a half-game lead in the NL West as late as August 19th, but were ten games behind the leader a month later and missed the post-season.
