Third baseman Chase Headley had an MVP-type season in leading the ball club with 31 homers, 115 RBI, 173 hits, 95 runs, and winning his first Gold Glove Award. Headley's RBI count also led the National League. He led all major league third basemen in games played (159), assists (315), and the N.L. in total chances (435). Carlos Quentin followed with 16 dingers. Yonder Alonzo was second on the team with 62 runs batted in and 150 base hits. For the season, the Padres hit .247 and 121 home runs...Clayton Richard's 14 wins led the pitching staff. Edinson Volquez (11-11 W/L record) was tops with 174 strikeouts. Lefty Eric Stults was an eight-game winner while Jason Marquis won six games before being traded. Closer Huston Street posted 47 K's and fellow reliever Luke Gregerson racked up 72 strikeouts. The pitching staff ended the year with a 4.01 ERA...The Padres opened the season with a 20-41 record and were 22 games below .500 by June 20th. By the All Star break they were 34-53 but ended the campaign going 42-33.
