Pablo Sandoval led the Giants with 23 homers, 70 RBI, 134 hits, and 55 runs scored. Cody Ross belted 14 home runs and drove in fifty-two. Aubrey Huff reached double-digits after hitting twelve homers and knocking in fifty-nine...Tim Lincecum, Madison Bumgarner, and Ryan Vogelsong led the pitching staff with thirteen wins apiece. Lincecum whiffed 220 batters; Bumgarner had 191 punch outs. Matt Cain was 12-11 and struck out 179 batters. Closer Brian "The Beard" Wilson won six games while striking out fifty-four...The Giants lost "Buster" Posey, the heart-and-soul of the ball club, for the season, May 25th, with a broken leg during a home plate collision. The defending World Champions finished eight games behind NL West winner, Arizona. They split their season series with the D-Backs, 9-9...The Giants hit 121 home runs and .242 as a team. The staff ERA was 3.20. The attendance at beautiful A T @ T Park was nearly 3.4 million--second in the league...They led the N.L. in ninth-inning comeback wins...Before his injury, Posey had four home runs and a .284 batting average.
