Michael Cuddyer led the Twins after belting 20 home runs, collecting 150 base hits, 70 runs scored, and 29 doubles for the year. Danny Valencia (15 homers) had a team high 72 RBI. Joe Mauer (three jacks, 30 RBI) was slowed by leg injuries and played just 82 games. Justin Morneau (69 games) suffered more concussion-type problems like those in 2010 and cracked four homers while driving in thirty. The ball club hit .247 and 103 home runs...Three pitchers each won nine games to lead the pitching staff: Carl Pavano, Brian Duensing, and Francisco Liriano. On May 3rd in Chicago, Liriano no-hit the White Sox although he struck out just TWO and issued six walks during a 1-0 victory. It was the franchise's fifth "no-no". Scott Baker led the staff with 123 strikeouts and finished the campaign 8-6 in wins/losses. The staff's ERA was 4.58...GM Bill Smith was fired after four years in the job and a season which saw the Twins go from first (2010) to last in 2011.
