At season's end, the D-Backs were ranked 13<sup>th</sup> in the National League with a .256 team BA and came in third with a bushel-full of home runs (191). Troy Glaus blasted 37 of those round-trippers and drove home 97 runs to lead the ballclub. Semi-regular Tony Clark (he appeared in 83 games at first base and 48 as a pinch-hitter) launched 30 homers and knocked in 87 in 349 at bats. Chad Tracy hit 27 jacks while driving in 72 runs; Luis Gonzalez (79 RBI) added 24 home runs and Shawn Green (73 RBI) 22 for the year...The pitching staff finished 14<sup>th</sup> in the N. L. with a 4.84 ERA. Brandon Webb had the most wins (14). Javier Vazquez (11 victories) rang-up the most strikeouts (192)...Arizona was tied for first of the NL West as late as July 31<sup>st</sup>, fell back as far as fourth, then sprinted home the final month 16-11 to finish five games out. They had won only 51 games in 2004.
