The dismal '79 campaign found the Mets finishing 35 games behind NL East champion Pittsburgh and 17 games in back of the fifth place Cubs. They won 28 games at home and 35 on the road...At the plate, the ball club hit .250 and 74 home runs while the pitching staff ended the year with a 3.84 ERA, good for eighth in the league...Joel Youngblood had a team high 16 homers and 90 runs scored. Lee Mazzilli slugged 15 dingers, led the Mets in hits (181), and tied Richie Hebner for the most RBI (79)...Craig Swan led the staff with 14 wins, 145 strikeouts, ten complete games, and three shutouts. Pete Falcone, Kevin Kobel, and Neil Allen all won six ball games.
