The Padres never played a major role in the NL West Division race. They fell below .500 April 21st and remained there the rest of the season. The team took ownership of last place in the division, August 14th, on the strength of a 19-34 record in August and September combined...As a team, the Padres hit .242 and 93 home runs. One great bright spot was super-star Dave Winfield's season after he led the ballclub in home runs (34), RBI (118), base hits (184), and runs scored (97). His RBI total led the National League. Winfield completed a personal "triple double" with 10 triples and 27 doubles. "Winny" also posted a .395 on-base percentage, .558 slugging percentage, and .953 OPS. Gene Tenace, among major league leaders in on-base percentage (.403), walked 105 times, slugged 20 homers, and drove home 67 runs...The pitching staff turned in a very respectable ERA of 3.69, fifth in the N. L. The group was paced by forty-year-old Gaylord Perry with his 12 wins, 140 strikeouts, and 10 complete games. One of the best finesse pitchers in the game, lefty Randy Jones, followed with 11 victories and 6 complete games. Bob Shirley whiffed 117 batters, Jones 112.
