The first season since their birth in 1962 the Mets did not finish at the bottom of the standings...Their record at the All Star break: 35-48, ninth place, 17 games out... **Team Leaders:** Ed Kranepool (16 HR); Ken Boyer (61 RBI); Jack Fisher, Dennis Ribant [10 CG], and Bob Shaw (all eleven wins); Fisher (127 K's, 10 CG). The Mets were last in the N. L. with a .239 BA and 93 HR. The staff ERA (4.17) placed them ninth...Nolan Ryan, 19, and a 12th round draft pick in 1965, debuted September 11th at Shea Stadium versus Atlanta, pitching two innings, striking out three and allowing 1 walk, 1 hit, and 1 earned run. He did not figure in the decision. Ryan's first career strikeout was Braves pitcher Pat Jarvis. Joe Torre hit the first homer Ryan allowed.
