In the ten team American League, the Senators finished the season eighth in hitting (.234) and seventh with 126 home runs. They scored the fewest runs (557). The pitching staff was eighth in ERA (3.70), allowing 659 runs... **Team Leaders:** Frank Howard (a.k.a. "The Capital Punisher") 18 HR and 71 RBI. Don Lock and Fred Valentine both hit 16 jacks. Valentine's 59 RBI were second to Howard. Pete Richert posted 14 wins and 14 losses on the mound along with 195 strikeouts to be the staff leader. Phil Ortega won 12 games; Mike McCormick contributed 11 W's...In the first week of April, the Solons dropped into the lower reaches of the A. L. and never recovered. After 81 games, they were in ninth place at 34-47 and 20 ½ games out of first place.
