One could say the history of the Padres franchise changed to a degree when shortstop Ozzie Smith was traded with pitcher Steve Mura to the Cardinals, December 1, 1981. In return, San Diego received two serviceable players, Sixto Lezcano and Garry Templeton, both of whom figured prominently in the starting line-up. In addition, future Hall of Famer Tony Gwynn debuted in the major leagues, July 19th, going two for four with a run scored and RBI against the Phillies. Talented catcher Benito Santiago, 17 years old from Puerto Rico, signed a free agent contract September 1st...As a ball club, the Padres spent nearly all of the season's first half in second place, reaching the halfway marker 3 ½ games behind. The second half did not go as well: 13 games under .500 with their largest deficit ten games, September 19th...Offensively, San Diego was led by Terry Kennedy's 21 homers (the team hit 81) and 97 RBI. Newcomer Lezcano was second to Kennedy in batting average: .289 to .295. Templeton hit .247 and was part of turning 70 double plays...Tim Lollar's 16 wins and 150 strikeouts paced the pitching staff. John Montefusco won ten ballgames. Rick Wise closed a career that began in 1964 with the Phillies when he was released in mid-April. He had won 188 games with five different teams and earned a reputation as a very good-hitting pitcher, posting a .195 BA and 15 home runs. He no-hit the Reds, 4-0, in 1971, helping his cause with two homers and three RBI. He also won Game Six of the 1975 World Series for Boston, the game in which a waving Carlton Fisk hit his famous 12th inning walk-off home run off the leftfield foul pole to win the game and tie the Series.
