

Center Court Foul Chart

Action #	Result
1-40	Defensive foul (non-shooting): If fouling team has 5 fouls this half, fouled team shoots 1-and-1. If fouling team has 9 fouls this half, fouled team shoots 2. Otherwise, fouled team starts over with action sequence.
41-50	Offensive charging foul: treat as a turnover; Opponent takes possession. This counts as a personal foul, but not a team foul.
51-95	Shooting foul on a 2-point field goal attempt: First draw cards to see who shot the FGA, and to determine if it was good. If good, give the shooter 1 free throw. If no good, give him 2.
96-98	Shooting foul on a 3-point field goal attempt: first draw cards to see who shot the 3FGA, and to determine if it was good. If good, give the shooter 1 free throw. If no good, give him 3.
99-100	Technical foul: First draw to see who committed the foul. If the number is not on the team chart, it's a technical on the coach/bench. Otherwise, its against the player whose "FOUL" range corresponds to the drawn number. Give the opponent 2 free throws, using your choice of shooter. Shooting team then gets possession. A player or coach who gets 2 technicals is ejected. For players, use the 2 nd number for future actions he might perform, thus selecting another player. For ejected coaches, subtract 2 from all his players' FG%, 3% and FT% ranges.
