enjoy, mainly: PTG College Basketball teams and fringe players and BLM Baseball and football teams. Your BLM college teams are especially enjoyable, with your extra college teams it is possible to play some interesting schedules. I'm disappointed in PTG for momentarily stopping production on PTG College Basketball for the '72-'73 season. We PTG fans enjoy each new edition and enjoy playing past teams against the present edition. It is possible to at least print the PTG college edition for '72-'73 in a sheet form which is very inexpensive and further enhanced by the fact that more blank cards would be purchased to copy these ratings on. In one of your recent issues I remember seeing an article on PTG Basketball and different innovations that can be added. Things like double-teaming, and use of a zone. I enjoy these ideas a great deal and recently sent you a shots per half and quarter rating for college and pro ball, I hope these are helpful. Another idea to use has occurred to me: you can use a zone by adding up all the defensive ratings on a team say it comes out to 15, (forget the foul rating that remains the same), then divide by 5. This comes out to 3 which is the rating you use for every player, in this way you can protect a weak defensive player - say a guard with a 2b rating.

I would enjoy more replays in your magazine and also ratings for BLM and PTG. BLM could rate more college football teams so that weak as well as strong teams are produced, I think you're been doing this to a greater extent, recently anyway. PTG college basketball teams are always appreciated, but why not some weak teams here, also. This would greatly increase interest if you produced say a Oregon State, Univ. of Toledo, Boston College, and Texas Christian. These are teams with large fan support but have had weaker teams than in the past.

I guess that about winds up this article but I would like to say thank you for the printing of all the BLM College Football teams for the 1970 season and the PTG teams for 1971-'72 which were enjoyed. In a game matching the '71-'72 Washington team against UCLA, Washington pulled the biggest upset I have ever had. They won 71-61 behind Steve Hawes 20 points and 12 rebounds. Bill Walton still scored 26 points and pulled in 19 rebounds in a gallant effort to bring UCLA back. In the end though, it was a matter of poor shooting - 33% from the floor and the fact that underrated Keith Wilkes fouled out with 10 minutes to go, with his steady rebounding and pinpoint shooting gone, UCLA's win streak was ended. I also played Arkansas University's 1970 team you rated in a 6 game replay: they ended the season 4-2. The two losses were to Houston and Nebraska, the National Champions. I kept complete statistics and was impressed by their accuracy, John Richardson was the leading rusher with about 580 yards and Joe Ferguson led the team in passing. All in all, I have to say keep improving your magazine, you owe it to your subscribers. So far you've been fulfilling your obligations to us.
